TRANSPORTATION COORDINATING COMMITTEE MINUTES OF JANUARY 3, 2008 REGULAR MEETING

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:32 a.m.
2. The December 6, 2007, meeting minutes were approved as written.

3. Prescott Fire Station No. 1 Site Access

a. Discussion

City Project Manager Ron Miller brought the preliminary site plan for the new Fire Station to be located at the intersection of Sheldon and Montezuma Streets for review and discussion. The north driveway currently shown 375 feet from the south edge of the intersection is problematic. Running the driveway parallel with Montezuma to a common intersection with the main driveway out of the Depot Marketplace was suggested, a distance of 500 feet from Montezuma/Sheldon. This driveway would provide access for administration, the railway bridge and west portion of Granite Creek Park, and should be restricted to right in/right out operation. Fire trucks would enter from the alleyway unless additional property is purchased providing a connection to Granite Street. Mayor Wilson mentioned that purchase of the property west of the fire station is to be considered by City Council. Chairman Williams stated that traffic is only going to get more congested, and the best access configuration for the long term should be pursued now.

b. Committee action/recommendation

No formal action taken. Public Works will prepare a memorandum to the City Council addressing access, summarizing the TCC discussion, and suggesting the benefits of acquiring the property to the west of the existing fire station property which would enable access via Granite Street.

5. Chairman's Report
