Surface Water Recharge Pipeline Replacement Project

The project generally consists of the installation of 10,070 LF of 36-inch steel reinforced polyethylene pipe, 1,208 LF of segmented pipe slip lining, installation of 25 manholes, and new intake structure on Granite Creek and Willow Creek, a new diversion structure on Willow Creek and new flume measurement equipment installation at the recharge ponds near the City Airport Sewer Plant. A. Miner Contracting was the low bidder and began construction on June 20th.

Construction began next to the Airport Wastewater Plant and has progressed south along the same route as the old CVID ditch line. The pipe line construction has been completed from the recharge basins at the Prescott Airport Sewer Treatment Plant to the junction of Granite Creek and Willow Creek. Some asphalt patching remains to be done in Corsair Avenue but this should not impact public traffic. The contractor has tied onto the pipe line at the south termination of Larry Caldwell Drive in Center Point West and has installed pipe to the junction of Willow Creek and Granite Creek. A. Miner Contracting has also slip lined the old existing pipe near the 89er Mobile Home Park, through the Kieckhefer Ranch and under Hwy 89. Work continues to be done on the junction structure and intake structures of Willow Creek and Granite Creek.
