 - S. Hassayampa from new Pump Station to Park Avenue

Description of work performed and traffic impact:

WATER LINE INSTALLATION

Monday, 5th through Thursday, April 8th – 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Final trench paving at the intersection of Montezuma and Aubrey Street and also along Hassayampa Drive from Park Avenue to the new Pioneer Pump Station and along Aubrey Street are complete. Next week the contractor is scheduled to pave Pioneer Drive and the area around the new Pioneer Pump Station.

Lanes may be restricted where crews are working.

Motorists will experience reduced speeds, narrow lanes, and possible flagging operations.

PIONEER PUMP STATION

Monday, 5th through Thursday, April 8th – 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Following the successful completion of the seven-day test of the new pump station and the fire flow tests, the new Pioneer Pump Station is now online. Contractor will perform miscellaneous work inside and outside of the Pump Station next week

Lanes may be restricted where crews are working.

Motorists will experience reduced speeds, narrow lanes, and possible flagging operations.

Access to homes in the affected area will be maintained and residents are asked to enter the work zone with caution.

Motorists should remain alert for construction workers and equipment at the intersection of Pioneer Drive and Hassayampa Drive and should follow well-marked detours. Please drive slowly and safely along detour routes.
