- Ballots were mailed to all eligible voters the week of October 16, 2017 through the U.S. Mail. Please contact us at 928-771-3248 if you have not received your ballot.
- All Ballots must be returned to the Yavapai County Recorder's Office or to a Ballot Drop Box location listed below no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 7, 2017.
