Please use this process to obtain approval for new street names assigned within City Limits
email your request to cat.moody@prescott-az.gov

Please include in your email the following:

- **Contact Name** for questions regarding this request
- **Contact Phone** number for above individual
- **Subdivision Name** where streets will be (are) located
- **Number of Names Required**
- Other Notes or information that will help us process your request (optional)

Please keep in mind these guidelines when choosing names:

There is a 17 character limit including spaces; no proper names or numbers; restricted names begin with-Eagle, Granite, Pine, Pinion, Prescott and Rock

Please submit at least 2 other choices for each name required. (If you do not do this the processing time will take longer if we have to come back to you for additional names should your first choices not meet requirements of the reviewing agencies).

To check your proposed names before submitting, go to the Yavapai County GIS site- <http://gis.yavapai.us/v4/>

Then use the “Location Search By” **Road Name** (see screen shot to left) to make sure your names do not conflict with other existing names in the database. This will increase your chances of presenting unique names for approval. Also consider that Dispatch agencies are concerned about the pronunciation of names and having spelling and formatting (one word vs. two words for names like Redtail/ Red Tail) be fairly simple and intuitive to aid in getting emergency personnel to a site as quickly as possible.
