



New Fire Auxiliary Positions Open to form “Community Services Unit” for City of Prescott Fire Department

The Prescott Fire Department is actively seeking individuals who wish to be part of a team of dedicated citizens willing to give their time to benefit our community. The members selected to join our team will support many different programs guided by the mission of the Prescott Fire Department.

As a member of the Fire Department’s Community Service Unit, you will have numerous opportunities including; providing citizen support of a non-emergent calls for service such as smoke alarm installation/repair, fire inspection services, pre-incident fire planning development, emergency medical services quality assurance/quality improvement, and many other specialized duties. The Community Service Unit may be called out for support at emergency situations if needed and they are expected to assist with some of the city’s major events as well as Public Education offerings.

All applicants must be at least 21 years of age with a valid Arizona driver’s license. Applicants must pass a background investigation with no felony convictions. Applicants are required to work a minimum of six hours a week and attend monthly meetings. Initial establishment of this new program will require approximately 7 auxiliary members, and recruitment will include a screening and interview process tailored to the program.
