
The National Community Survey™ in Prescott

The NCS™ for Prescott, AZ

- First time conducting The NCS
- Survey conducted from October 10, 2023 November 21, 2023
- Mailing approach employed:
 - Probability-based sample of 3,000 randomly selected households
 - 770 total responses received
 - 27% overall response rate
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Prescott overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 3% margin of error
- Non-probability, open-participation survey: 270 responses








Facets of Community Livability: Quality











The Natural Environment in Prescott



Overall quality of natural environment in Prescott, 2023










Prescott residents feel safe and indicate support for additional investment in public safety.




Safety in Prescott












Please indicate to what degree you would support or oppose each of the following approaches to balancing public safety response times with the associated costs.




Potential Uses for Additional Revenue


