

Downtown Bollard Installation Project – Updated Project Schedule

April 1, 2025

The City of Prescott and their contractor, Combs Construction Company, continue installing removable bollards in the downtown area at select intersections (shown on the map). These bollards will be used for traffic control during parade routes and special events. The opening of Location 2 (intersection of Gurley/Montezuma) will be slightly delayed to allow the newly installed concrete to properly cure in this high traffic intersection. Bollard installation in Location 3 (Willis/Montezuma) will take place after the Whiskey Off-Road event (April 25-27), due to material supply delays. The updated schedule is shown below.

Intersections will be fully closed, 24 hours a day,
for bollard installation on these dates:

**Bollard Location 1 and 4 (intersections of
Gurley/Cortez and Union/Cortez):**

Complete

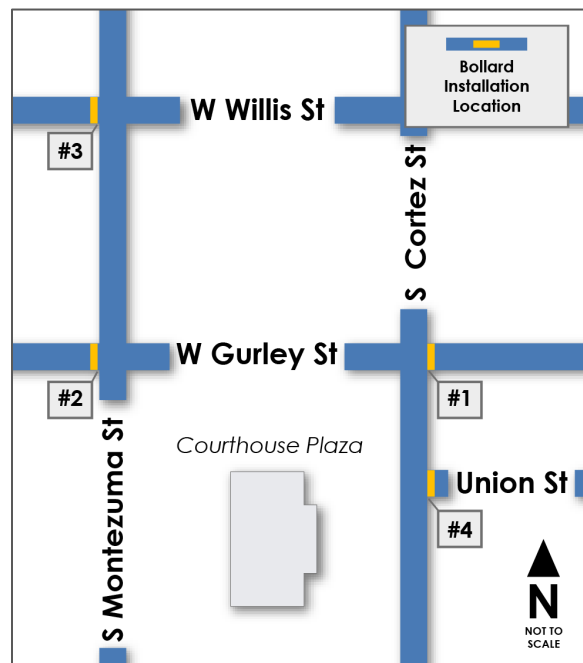
**Bollard Location 2 (intersection of
Gurley/Montezuma):**

Scheduled to be complete on April 7

**Bollard Location 3 (intersection of
Willis/Montezuma):**

Postponed until after Whiskey Off-Road event
(April 25-27)

Construction may occur Monday through Saturday, from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Detour routes will be posted during these closure times. Please follow the marked signage to get to your destination. On-street parking restrictions will be in place during this work. We appreciate your support and understanding as we work to improve Downtown Prescott.
