City of Prescott Veterans Day Parade Rules

- 1. Check in must be done outside the Social Security office building on Marina St by 10am.
- 2. No discharging of any type of firearm is allowed
- 3. No throwing anything to the crowds. Items can be passed out or handed out along the parade route. Failure to comply will result in removal from the parade.
- 4. If you are performing in a group, you must perform on the parade route without interrupting the progress of the parade unless approval has been obtained by the parade committee.
- 5. If you have animals as part of your entry, you will need to provide your own "pooper scooper".
- 6. Each entry is eligible for only ONE category trophy. There will be a 1st place award in each category, as well as a Best Over All Award.
- 7. No more than 20 vehicles, horses or other animals per entry. Please drive/ride/walk the route 2x2 (side-by-side)
- 8. Only walking entries will be allowed to re-enter the staging area at Willis St. All motorized entries will go back to staging area, if needed via surface roads. Traffic laws must be obeyed.
- 9. There will be a numbers drop off at the end pf the parade at Willis St. Please remember to return your entry number.
- 10. Winning entries will be notified via email to pick up awards. Awards can be picked up at the Recreation Services office, 824 E. Gurley St, M-F 8am to 4pm
