Transfer Station Master Plan

October 2025

TRANSFER STATION PROJECT

The project goal is to deliver a quality Master Plan that accomplishes overall assessment of space use and siting needs of the City of Prescott Solid Waste Transfer Station with consideration for operational impacts on surrounding environment, community, and users.

The project will generally include recommendations/plans for optimal site use to include paving and routing plans for ingress, egress, and facility access through striping and signage with consideration for mitigation of operational impacts of light, dust, noise, odors, and traffic. Siting and sizing recommendations will also be included for a new $\pm 14,500$ SF transfer station with one pull-through load-out tunnel to handle future solid waste volumes. Improvements for site security and safety, fencing and landscape plans for safety and visual/operational buffers, segregation of residential traffic from the commercial and transfer station truck traffic, retrofitting the existing transfer station to provide a location for recycling, household hazardous waste and storage, as well as recommendations for drainage improvements.

The contract to create the Master Plan has been awarded to JRMA Architects Engineers. The architectural firm has met with staff on a couple of occasions to present their alternative conceptual plans. Those conceptual plans are currently under review.
