Transfer Station Master Plan

March 2026

TRANSFER STATION MASTER PLAN

The project objective is to produce a comprehensive Master Plan following a detailed assessment of space and siting needs of operators and customers while also considering the operational impacts on adjacent properties, the environment, the greater community, and users.

The project generally consists of various site changes to improve facility operations and safety, including improvements to facility ingress, egress, and site routing, operational changes to mitigate light, dust, noise, odors, and traffic, site and sizing assessment for a new $\pm 14,500$ square foot transfer station with one pull-through load-out tunnel to accommodate future solid waste volumes, general site security and safety improvements, specific fencing and landscape changes to improve facility safety and provide better visual buffers, segregate residential, commercial, and transfer station truck traffic, retrofit the existing transfer station building to provide better operations for recycling, household hazardous waste acceptance and storage, and improved collection and conveyance of on-site storm water drainage.

JRMA Architects and Engineers was awarded the Master Plan design contract in May 2025. The city plans for a 90% design review in February 2026, present the draft master plan at the March 10th City Council Study Session, and complete the master plan by August 2026.
