Prescott Fire Training Tower

PUBLIC SAFETY PROJECT

The Prescott Fire Training Tower consists of a NFPA Certified Custom Fabricated Live Fire and Confined Space Five (5) Story Training Facility specifically prepared for the Prescott Fire Department. The work includes but is not limited to the training tower and foundations, site preparation, to include removal of the existing concrete slab, and importing select subgrade materials, and grading to provide for positive drainage away from the tower.

Construction of the project started February 24, 2026. Removal of existing improvements, over-excavation of unsuitable materials, and placement of new Aggregate Base Course (ABC) have been completed. Concrete work is currently underway and is expected to be completed by mid-May. The delivery and erection of the tower have been rescheduled to early June. This delay is not expected to affect the project overall schedule. The project remains on track for completion by the end of June 2026.
