3. Avenues for public comment

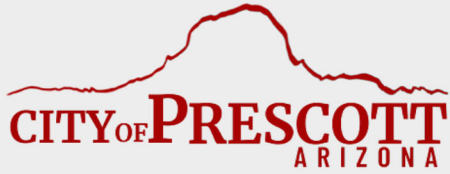
