



## **Prescott Freedom Festival 4th of July Event FAQ's**

**Location:** Pioneer Park, 1200 Commerce Dr, Prescott, AZ 86305

**Event Time:** 3:00 PM – 10:00 PM

**Gates Open:** 2:00 PM

**Fireworks Start:** 9:00 PM

### **What can I bring?**

Guests are encouraged to bring sunscreen, hats, towels, seating, pop-up shades or umbrellas, sealed water bottles, and snacks or food if desired. We will have food trucks at the event.

### **What items are prohibited?**

No outside alcohol, no open containers (event goers can expect bag and cooler checks at security screening areas), no animals (only service animals are permitted), no smoking/vaping in the park or within 50 feet of the park, no BBQ grills (charcoal or propane), no sparklers or any other firework features are permitted.

### **Is seating reserved?**

No. Seating is first come, first served. There is no VIP seating or pre-purchase seating available.

### **Where can I park?**

Parking will be available at Pioneer Park with limited periphery parking spots will be available at the ADOT Motor Vehicle Division building located at 1105 Commerce Dr. Parking at both locations is limited.

### **Will shuttle service be available?**

Yes. Shuttles will run from Potter's House Church Parking Lot located at 5195 AZ-89, Prescott, AZ 86301. Shuttles begin at 2:30 PM. The last shuttle to the park departs at 8:30 PM. Return shuttles to Potter's House Church will begin after the fireworks conclude.

### **Will there be food and drinks available?**

Yes. Food trucks will be onsite throughout the event, and there will also be an adult beverage tent selling adult beverages for guests 21 and older.

**Is there an admission fee?**

No. The event is free to attend.

**Will there be live entertainment?**

Yes. Live music will take place from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

**What other activities will be happening at the event?**

There will be water slides, bounce houses, games, mechanical bull, corn hole, giant yard pong and more to entertain the young and young at heart. There will also be a hotdog eating contest for those who wish to compete. (All activities are also free)

**Will commemorative merchandise be available?**

Yes. The first 250 attendees will receive a complimentary commemorative shirt. A limited number of America 250 commemorative shirts will also be available for purchase at the event and will be available on our website soon for those wishing to preorder.

**Can I leave my vehicle overnight?**

No. Overnight parking is not permitted at any event parking location.

**Is camping allowed at the event or parking areas?**

**Will there be road closures associated with the event?**

Yes. Traffic control will restrict access and institute road closures at various times to ensure driver and pedestrian safety during and after the event. Please check the website for updates on event traffic control procedures.
