## Montezuma Rainwater Harvesting

September 2026

### **UTILITY PROJECT**

As part of the City of Prescott Green Stormwater Infrastructure Program, Public Works is designing rainwater harvesting and stormwater filtering vegetated areas along the west side of S Montezuma Street in the right-of-way south of the intersection with Carleton Street. A public meeting was held in July to present 30% designs to the public for comment. Public Works is now proceeding toward a 90% design.

The project consists of curb cuts, sediment traps, and stormwater basins designed to trap sediment, filter stormwater through vegetation, and beautify the downtown corridor in the Prescott Original Townsite subdivision. Stormwater features will reduce *E. Coli* loads into Granite Creek, which carries a USEPA impairment for high *E. Coli* and low dissolved oxygen.

Construction is anticipated to occur in the spring of 2027, with planting and educational signage installation to follow.
